Office Financial Policy

Your dental health is our utmost concern. Therefore, we offer several flexible payment options to assist in allowing you to complete your recommended dental treatment. Below is a list of our standard payment options.

1. Forms of payment that we accept:

Visa, Mastercard, Personal Check *with copy of your valid driver's license, Cashier's Check and Cash.

2. Finance Options Available:

In-House: 3 to 6months, 0% interest, 30% deposit required to activate.

*To qualify for this plan, you will need to sign a payment plan agreement form with our Office Manager and place a Visa or Mastercard credit/debit card # on file. Automatic payment will be made to your card every 30 days. The amount of payment and the due date of your payment will be arranged in advance at your surgical consultation appointment.

Care Credit Financing: We only participate in the 24 to 60 month interest bearing finance programs. The current interest rate is 13.9%. *We do not participate in their 0% interest free programs since we currently offer our in-office interest free option.

3. Dental Insurance Assignment of Benefits to Dr. Darryl A. Field:

We currently provide the service of filing your dental insurance claims with verified PPO dental insurance companies. To utilize this service, you will need to provide our front office staff with your current dental insurance card, your date of birth and social security #. If the insured is your spouse, their date of birth and their social security # will be needed as well.

We will happily file your dental insurance claims at time of treatment and attach all supporting documentation to help expedite the payment of your claims. In the event that your insurance policy does not pay as much as originally estimated, the remaining balance will be sent to you in a billing statement via mail. Please submit payment within 30 days to clear the balance remainder.

*If you want to avoid any risk of your insurance estimate not being exact, you may request a pre-treatment estimate to be sent to your insurance carrier 4 to 6 weeks prior to having your dental procedure performed.

Once we receive a reply from your insurance carrier of the quoted estimated benefits allowable for that treatment, an updated treatment plan and a copy of your pre-estimate will be sent to you via mail. You may then call our office to reserve your dental appointment for your procedure. Please see Michelle for all pre-treatment requests.
